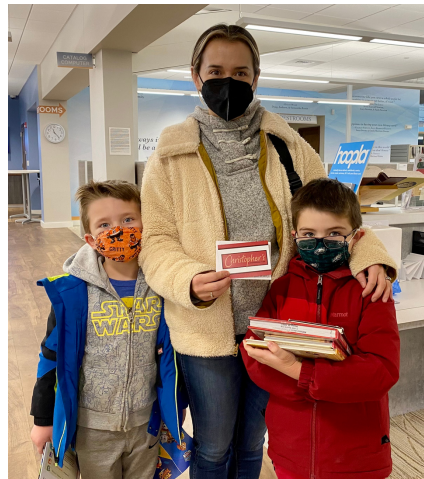

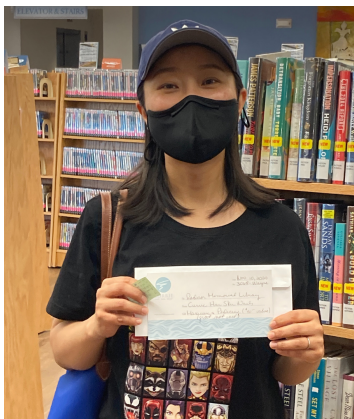

Inez J. and Justin M. McCarthy

In 2021, Dan McCarthy contacted Radnor Memorial Library to let us know that his parents, Inez and Justin, left a sizeable donation to the Library in their will. We quickly learned of the McCarthys' love of the Library during their lifetime.

Inez J. McCarthy was a dedicated volunteer and served as president of the Friends of Radnor Memorial Library for many years in the mid-1990s. Inez is remembered dearly by many of our staff members for her passionate support of the Library as well as her tenacity, wit, and polished poise. She often brought her children to the Library when it was located on Lancaster Avenue and they spoke with fondness of their adventures among the stacks when they were young.

Inez was, to her core, an altruistic individual. Her daughter, Anne, recalled how every time her mother would pick her up from swim practice in high school, there would be a library book in the front seat of the car. While Inez was an avid reader, these books weren't for her. Instead, she would check out and deliver books to the elderly throughout the community who couldn't make it to the Library. Each patron's book preferences were logged in a meticulously kept notebook.

Inez and her husband, Justin, were committed to serving the Radnor Township community. This commitment continued in their estate planning. Radnor Memorial Library was one of the local organizations that the McCarthys chose to honor after their passing. Their generous planned gift will allow us to continue to promote a love of reading and learning within our community for generations to come.
