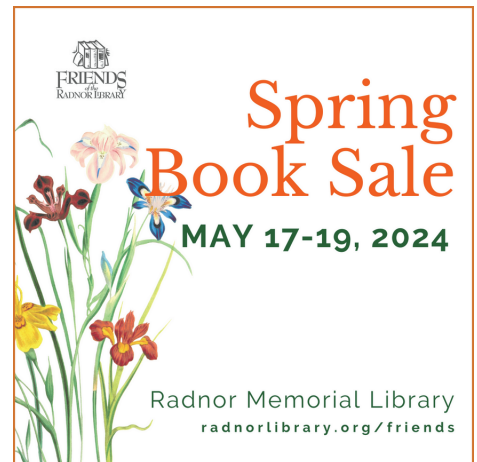
AN AFTERNOON WITH AUTHOR
