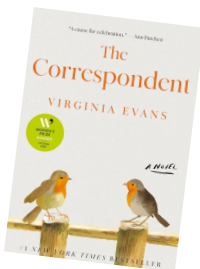
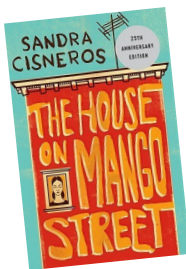

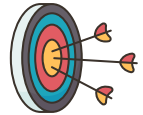


THE SCIENCE OF SOCCER: ENGINEERED BY THE FRANKLIN INSTITUTE
